Delegate Selection for the 2012 Democratic National Convention starts March 10 in Anderson County

Local Democrats to host County Convention to begin delegate selection

The Anderson County Democratic Party will host a County Convention at noon on March 10 at Anderson County High School to begin delegate selection for the 2012 Democratic National Convention.

Registration begins at 11 a.m. The local convention is open to any bona fide Democrat in Anderson County.

Any Democrat wishing to become a Delegate to the 2012 Democratic National Convention must vote in the March 6 Democratic Primary and declare their candidacy by filling out a Statement of Candidacy and Pledge of Support form available at www.TNDP.org. Completed forms must be returned by March 1.

On March 10, participants at the county convention will elect a group of county representative to attend the Congressional District Convention to be held on March 24.

Representatives elected from each county in the Congressional District, based on 2010 lines, will elect the Delegates to the Democratic National Convention. Locations for the March 24 Congressional District Conventions will be announced at the County Convention.,

Delegate application forms are due March 1 by 12 p.m. CST.
